OUR MOTIVATION

Parents whose children have special needs have two vital questions:

1. What happens when my child ages out of the school system?
2. What will happen to my child after I am gone?

OUR SOLUTION

Living Unlimited solves the problem of where adults with special needs will live and thrive after they leave their parents' home. LU accomplishes this by gathering families and providing the framework for creating affordable, stable, secure housing and community complete with property management and oversight of care. This ensures that those who require additional supports may live as independently as possible.



OUR ROAD TO HOME

LU's mission is to create and support safe, stable and enjoyable housing and community for people with intellectual and developmental disabilities. An LU Community will offer a home and the opportunity to live a supported, balanced, and fulfilling life with dignity and purpose, accessing meaningful occupation and cultural/spiritual activities, with the goal of reaching one's full potential and as much independence as possible.



OUR IDEA

The LU housing concept promotes three different community types for LU to oversee and manage.

Intentional: A single integrated site (usually rural) with plenty of homes, land and on site shared amenities.

Clustered: Single family homes near each other (primarily suburban). Can be gradually created one house at a time. Satisfies CMS goal of community and neighborhood integration. Amenities shared among all properties.

Multi-Units: Apartments (usually in an urban setting) with easy access to city amenities. Easier to finance than many realize. Rents of neurotypical residents supplement ID/DD residents' rent.
